The Digital Divide

The gap between people who have internet access and those who don't.

Three main challenges:

Availability

Adoption

Affordability

What's the Impact?

- 2 million California households (15%) still lack reliable internet access.
- 28% of rural Americans & 25% of people in tribal lands lack high-speed broadband vs. just 1.5% of urban residents.
- 35% of Latino & 29% of Black households lack home broadband vs. 20% of white households.





California Middle Mile Network


GOLDENSTATENET was formed to build affordable open-access broadband connections through middle-mile infrastructure across California.

- State-funded 3,600+ mile fiber statewide network
- Partners
 - CENIC
 - California Department of Technology (CDOT)
 - Caltrans
- Sonoma County Routes
 - Highway 101
 - Highway 116 & parts of Highway 1
- Expected Completion December 2026

WiConduit Grant Award

- Amount: \$17+ million awarded to expand broadband in Sonoma County.
- Grantor: California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC)
- Partners: GigabitNow & Local Internet Providers
- Contractor: Cannon Companies
- Design: Underground, Open Access, Fiber Optic Network
- Locations: Forestville and Sonoma Coast
- Serving: 800+ unserved locations
- Timeline: End of 2026





Construction Standards


What to expect

- Trench in public right of way.
- Underground boring wherever necessary.
- Underground drop to home if feasible.
- Traffic control during construction.
- Hire local subcontractors for network build.
