Purpose of Town Hall

Obtain feedback from community on traffic solutions for Penngrove:

- Discuss traffic study and discuss short term and long-term solutions and discuss prioritization list.
- Design of Ely/Old Redwood Hwy roundabout, Railroad/Old Redwood roundabout.
- Other traffic calming applications and ideas that support Penngrove commerce and community



Penngrove Traffic Study: Final Report

Traffic Study Prepared by: GHD Inc.

Purpose: Address traffic concerns in Penngrove, including:

- Regional cut-through traffic
- Travel speeds, safety, and emergency delays
- School traffic at Penngrove Elementary

Study Area: Includes Penngrove and surrounding areas (Petaluma, Rohnert Park, Santa Rosa)



Traffic Study Goals:

- Improve traffic congestion, mobility, and safety
- Address regional growth impacts
- Respond to community concerns

Traffic Study Key Findings:

- Over 50% of traffic originates from nearby cities
- Adobe Road serves as a key route to Highway 12



Community Input

Town Hall Meeting (Spring 2023):

Key concerns: safety, high speeds, school access, cut-through traffic

Concerns: Stalks balder Boundtable (Fall 2004)

Community Stakeholder Roundtable (Fall 2024)

 Discussed solutions, signage and AB43 speed limit adjustments and intersection designs

Online Survey (May-June 2023):

- 65% concerned about high speeds
- 76% support traffic calming measures

Interactive Map:

691 comments, focus on reducing speeds on major roads

Outreach to property owners adjacent to the proposed roundabouts (Spring/Summer 2025)

Shared intersection designs and discussed property impacts



Key Concerns

- Safety
- Speeds
- School Congestion
- Traffic Growth



Recommended Phase 1 Improvements Completed by 2030

- Enhance pedestrian crossings
- Add traffic calming signage
- Consider speed reductions in specific areas (Petaluma Hill Road and Old Redwood Highway)
- Narrow lanes to reduce speeds
- Consider adding buffers in areas to bike lanes
- Intersection improvements (Railroad/ORH, Ely/ORH and Main Street/Adobe and Main/Woodward)

Possible Phase 2 could include

- Re-stripping to reduce lane width and create turn pockets
- Safety improvements at intersections
- Adding path along Adobe Road from the SMART Path to Penngrove School





Sonoma Marin Area Rail Transit (SMART) signalization planning is underway:

Signal at Main street/Woodward is in design.

Construction is not fully funded yet. This will be installed during construction of the Rohnert Park/Penngrove section

Projects/Improvements in Progress


- Speed monitoring with county radar trailers
- Pavement Preservation Program FY24/25
 - Hatchery Road ORH to Goodwin
 - o Minnesota Ave ORH to end of County Road
 - Penngrove Ave ORH to Minnesota Ave
 - Cypress Ave W Railroad to end of County Road
- Improved Signage
 - Solar speed sign Petaluma Hill Rd
 - Solar speed sign on Old Redwood Highway
 - Flashing speed sign at school zone with new location
 - Flashing crossing sign Adobe Rd
 - Welcome Banners North & Southbound Main Street organized by Penngrove Social Firemen








EXISTING PENNGROVE TRAFFIC SIGNS LOCATIONS




NEW PENNGROVE TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICES







EXISTING PENNGROVE TRAFFIC SIGNS LOCATIONS

NEW PENNGROVE TRAFFIC PAVEMENT MARKINGS PLACEMENT






<u>Intersection Improvement:</u> <u>Railroad Ave / Old Redwood Hwy</u>

- Design underway for round-about design- 65 percent
- Construction timeline: in design 2026, construction 2027
- Outreach to adjacent property owners underway
- \$5.5 million









<u>Intersection Improvement:</u> <u>Ely Road / Old Redwood Hwy</u>

- Design underway for Round-about (65 percent)
- Construction timeline: Design 2026, construction 2027
- Outreach to adjacent property owners is underway
- \$3 million








<u>Intersection Improvement:</u> <u>Main Street / Petaluma Hill</u>

- Design Complete for signal improvements
- Currently paused for community input
- Right of Way acquisition phase
- Construction timeline: shovel ready
