Subject: Continuum of Care (CoC) Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) Reallocation Approval

SUMMARY:

During the Homeless Coalition Board meeting on January 28, 2026, the board approved three project proposals for the reallocated funding from the Buckelew Programs SCIL Sonoma Project. It was later found by staff when completing the application for the Coordinated Entry (CE) Expansion project that it is not permissible to replace state/local funding for projects already in existence. The item presented to the board for approval was to remove funding from the CE Operator contract from the local Homeless Services Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) and replace with CoC funds, not add additional funding. In addition, the Department of Health Services just finished the Request for Proposals for the CE Operator following County Procurement policies and we are unable to increase their contract.

Because proposals must be submitted no later than February 9, 2026, the CoC needs to reallocate \$39,387 in remaining funds to an existing project. Staff contacted COTS to ask if they could increase their request for the Community-Based Permanent Supportive Housing Expansion project to use these remaining funds. COTS stated they are not interested in requesting any additional funding, even a partial amount.

Given the short timeline and the need to include all funds in applications by the deadline, staff recommend adding the \$39,387 to the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) Expansion project. This is the only other project requesting reallocated funding. The Board approved an HMIS Expansion request of \$165,000 on January 28. With this change, the total request would increase to \$204,387.

The added funds would result in a small increase of \$9,847 in HMIS participation fees, spread across approximately 22 agencies. The funds would be used for HMIS-related

needs such as vendor trainings for HMIS Lead, an HMIS vendor Request for Proposals, HMIS Lead oversight, and support for the HMIS Data Committee and Homeless Coalition Board, etc.

Since no other CoC projects submitted proposals of interest and COTS declined additional funding, staff are recommending this option.
