

**Letter of Interest for Community Based Organization (CBO)
Representative Membership on the Sonoma County
Community Corrections Partnership (CCP)**

The California Legislature enacted the Public Safety Realignment Act in 2011, which mandated sweeping changes to the criminal justice system by shifting the responsibility for managing select adult offenders from the state to each of the 58 counties. Senate Bill 678 and Assembly Bill 109 requires each county to establish a Community Corrections Partnership (CCP) that oversees funds allocated pursuant to this act. These funds shall be used to provide supervision and rehabilitative service for adult felony offenders subject to probation and shall be spent on evidence-based community corrections practices and programs, as defined under existing law.

Per governing statutes, the CCP membership shall include a representative from a community-based organization with experience in successfully providing rehabilitative services to persons who have been convicted of a criminal offense.
