In compliance with AB 361 (2021) and in order to continue to conduct teleconference meetings not subject to the usual Brown Act teleconference rules, the Commission will consider the circumstances regarding the state of emergency declared by the Governor regarding the COVID-19 pandemic which continues in existence; and the continued recommendations or impositions by State and local officials to promote social distancing; and whether the continued presence of COVID-19 in the State continues to directly impact the ability of the Commission and other governmental all bodies in the State to meet safely in person without presenting an imminent risk to the health and safety of attendees.

The Operating Committee will also consider the appointment of County Counsel of Kern County as general counsel to the Agency.

A. Consider and take action regarding contract with Norton Rose Fulbright US LLP

The fee for services provided by the law firm of Norton Rose Fulbright US LLP (including accrued and unbilled time and anticipated work through June 30, 2023) is estimated at \$22,000 for administrative services and \$22,500 for continuing disclosure work. This fee remains the same as for the prior year (2021-22).
